The visit Behind the Scenes will help you learn a lot about the day-to-day management of a place like the Wild Zoo. You will be allowed into areas to which the general public normally doesn't have access and you will see some of the planning and organisation that goes into ensuring the wellbeing and good health of the animals in our collection. Behind the Scenes is a very popular activity that answers a lot of the questions you had in mind.

Saturdays and Sundays: in July (12-13, 19-20, 26-27), and in August (2-3, 9-10, 16-17). The visits are scheduled for the late afternoon. Cost: \$5 for adults and \$3 for children under 12. This visit lasts one hour. Reserve your place when you arrive at the Zoo.
